• influential

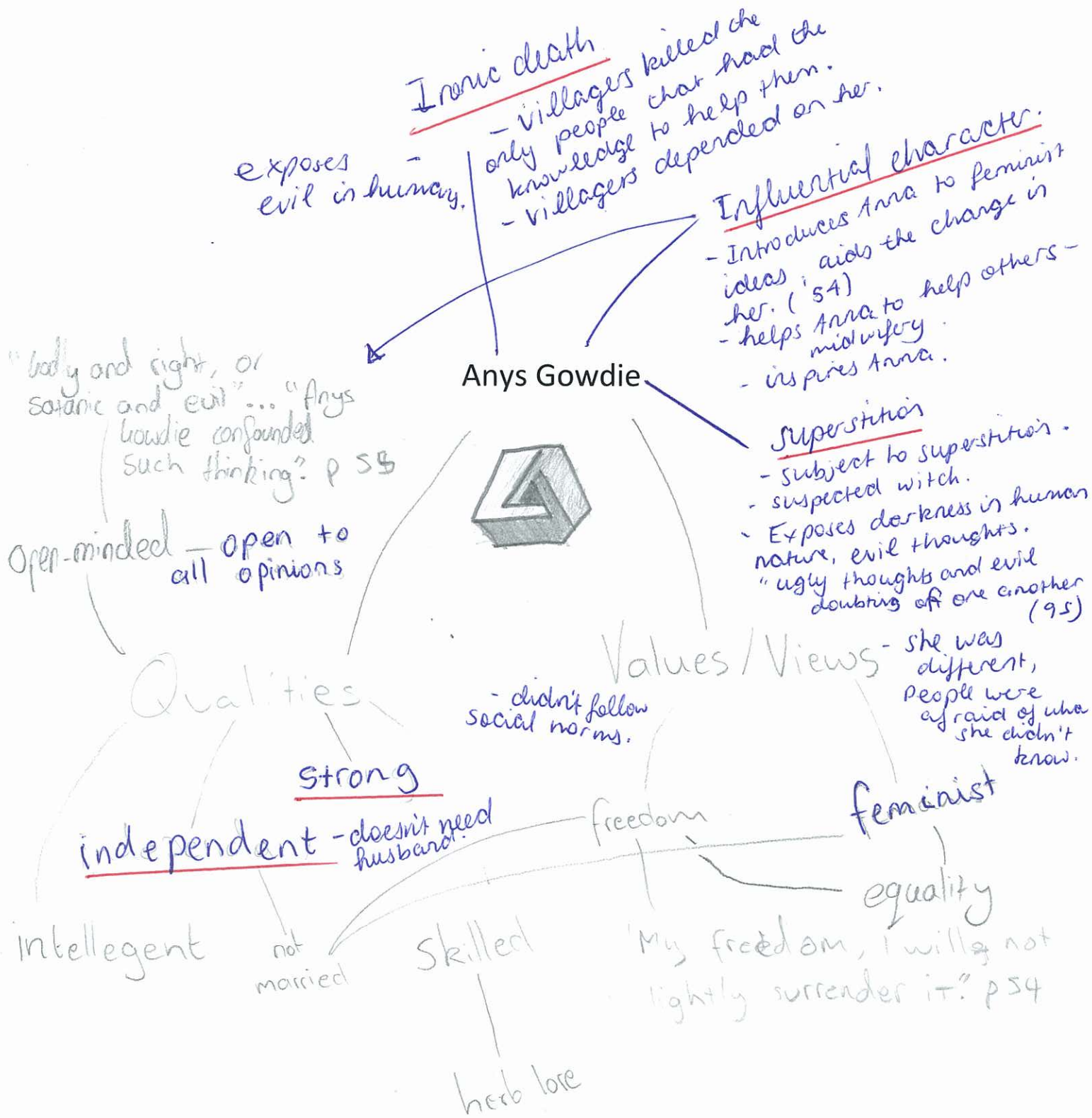

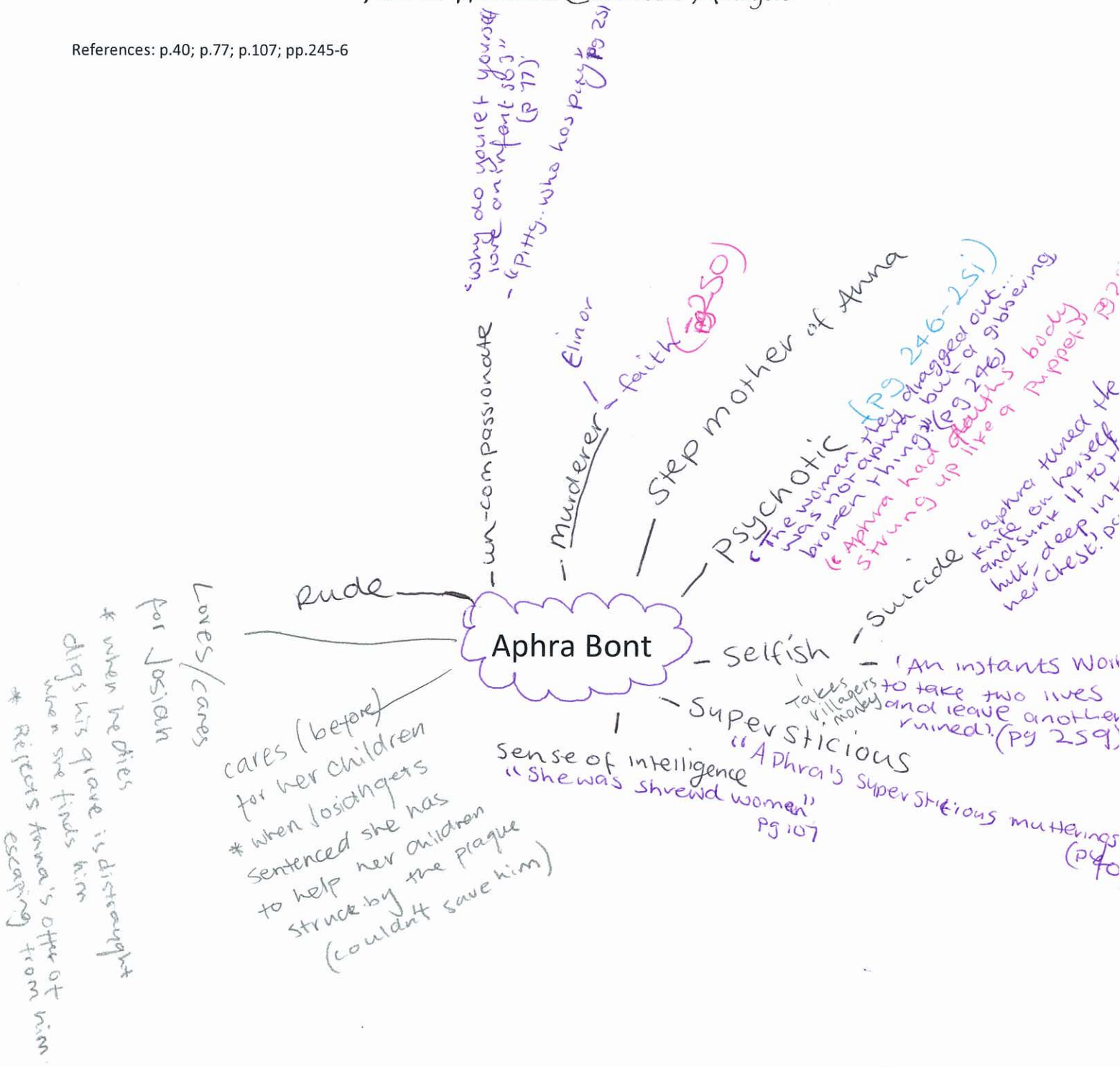

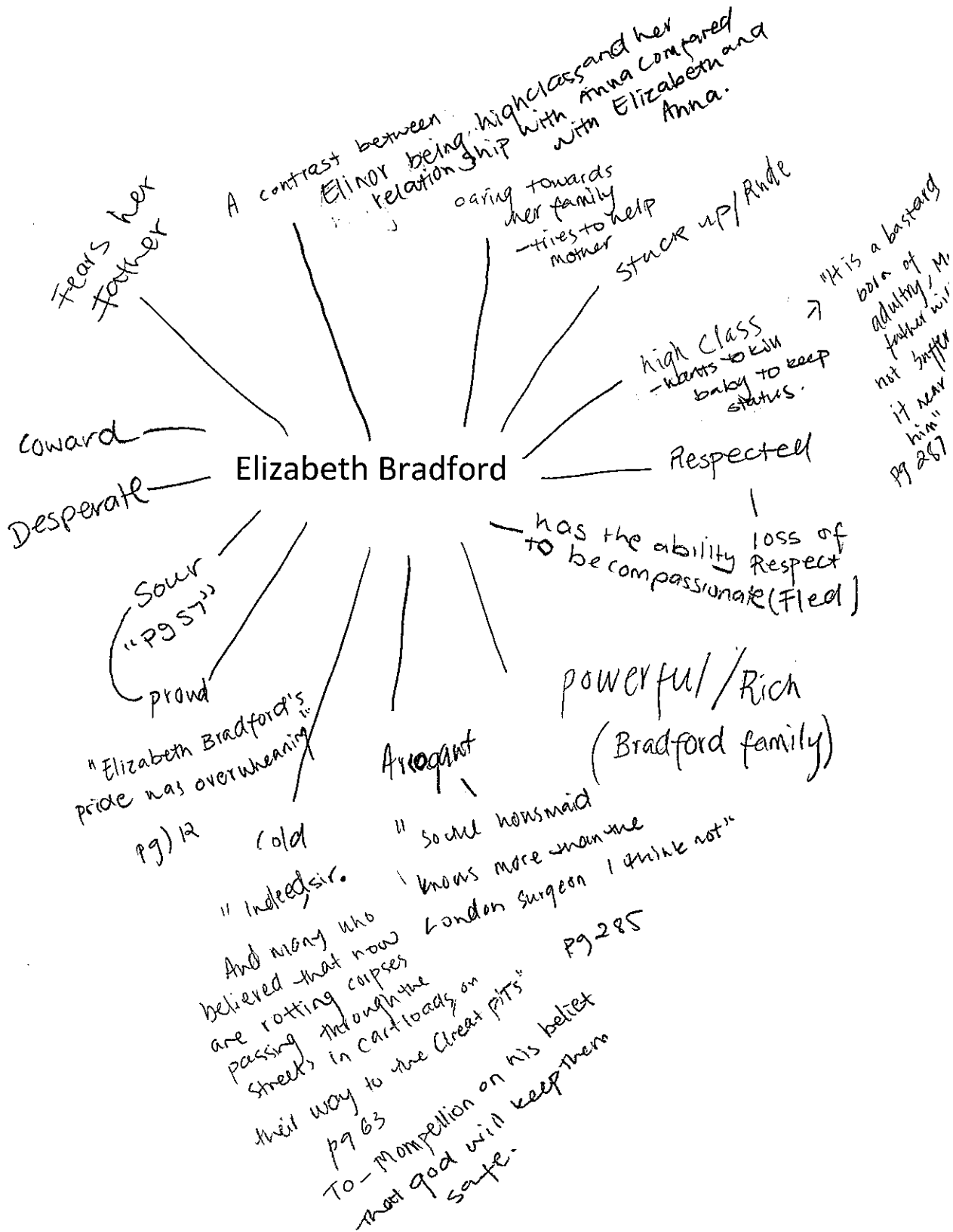
